It hit me last Sunday in church.

The hand-written note on our bulletin board ... from a pastor in Texas, who received our "love-bucket" money from two weeks ago.

As I'm leading the service ... looking out at those of you who are here ... later, as I see you coming up to the altar to receive the gifts of bread and wine ... my heart gets full ... my soul is going in all kinds of different directions ... I realize anew how real God's spirit is.

As imperfect as we are and can be ... God lives in the very fiber of our being.

As small and as imperfect as our church is ... in the cosmic stream of things ... God lives

and breathes in the small acts of kindness we bring unto others.

As crazy as the world is ... as much sadness and heartache as there is on our planet earth ...

there are also incredible moments of goodness and grace ----

coming alive in ordinary folks in ordinary places.

I had a funeral yesterday afternoon ... for a lady who leaves behind no family. The only people there were a few of her neighbors and friends ---- maybe 15 people. Her "best friend" comes up to me before the service. She asks me ----- "I'm sorry there are so few people

here. And you didn't even know her ... what are you going to say?"

I smile ... give her a gentle hug: "Don't you worry. I'm the minister of a church ... where the people teach me what to say, just by being who they are. Besides ... she had a friend like you ---- it's gonna be ok." I shared these words with the "gathered few."

"When through one woman a little more love and goodness ... a little more light and truth ... come into the world ----- then, that woman's life has had meaning."

We have a good place here.

Good ... far from perfect ... but a place graced with folks like you ------ who deeply care about each other, and the wider human community. This is what life is all about.

I wish more of you would come on Sunday or Thursday night.

I wish we would "pack the house" every Sunday.

But most important ... we "pack the house with love."

We sing and pray and laugh and cry ----- because God's spirit is so real. It lives and breathes in the journeys we share ... in the moments we too often take for granted.

Sunday during Communion ... we are singing "Kum Ba Yah" ------ someone's singing, Lord ... someone's crying, Lord ... someone's praying, Lord ...

Got a few goosebumps, hearing this often-made-fun-of song. What's really good is knowing ... as we sing, and pray, and cry and even laugh and sing "alleluia" ... there is an amazing God who sings and prays and cries ... right along with us. **love and joy to all "rev"**
