## **OUR ANNUAL REQUEST FOR YOUR SUPPORT**

Most of you know our fund-raising is pretty low-key ... and simple.

In fact ... the only "major fund-raiser" we have ... outside of offering envelopes ... is the spaghetti dinner in February. Anyway ------ we hope you will consider making a commitment for calendar year 2019.
 Please know ----- whatever you pledge/give during the year is strictly confidential. Our comptroller – Kathy Klang – keeps all of our giving records.

A couple notes:

\*our weekly attendance (Sunday and Thursday) is the same as last year ... 320 this year, 319 last year.
\*Our goal is to have our "offering income" cover budgeted expenses. We definitely fall short of doing this ... but we do get other monies that make up the difference.

For example: \*last year ... our budgeted expenses were \$531,000 ... offering income \$450,000 ... total income ... \$550,000.

\*so far this year (we still have December) ... offering only income \$400,000 ... budgeted expenses \$486,000 ... total income so far \$498,000.

We would like to narrow the gap between expenses and offering income ... so we aren't so dependent on "other income." But the good news is ---- we pay our bills, we do have money in the bank ... and hopefully, with broader support from everyone ... we can stay on solid footing.
